- Who?** All Palo Alto Girl Scouts in 6th-12th grade and chaperoning women. We need 1 adult for every 3-6 girls. Please join us for an adventure.
- When?** January 19, 2008 at 5:30 AM until January 20 at 9 PM.
- What?** Explore Yosemite Valley on Saturday, Ice Skate in evening. Sleep in heated cabins (Dinner and breakfast at Curry Village). Ski (downhill or cross-country), or snowboard on Sunday.
- Where?** Travel from Palo Alto to Yosemite Valley, ski Sunday at Badger Pass.
